CHAPTER 48

YELVERTON'S ACT (IRELAND) 1781 [I]

- Provisions by 10 H. 7. c.22 (I.) and of acts passed in G.B. relative to Ireland, since that period extended to
- [I.] all statutes for settling forfeited estates and private acts, relative to landed property, or concerning commerce or seamen to be of force in this kingdom.
- II So long as they bind subjects of G.B.
- III And all English laws respecting stile or calendar, or continuance of any office, commission, or writ, &c. at law to be used as heretofore.
