### 1776 CHAPTER 53 17 Geo 3

An Act to promote the Residence of the Parochial Clergy by making Provision for the more speedy and effectual building, rebuilding, repairing or purchasing Houses and other necessary Buildings and Tenements for the Use of their Benefices.

# 13 Colleges in Oxford and Cambridge, and other corporate bodies patrons of livings, may lend any sums without interest, to aid the execution of this Act.

And it shall and may be lawful for any college or hall within the universities of Oxford and Cambridge, or for any other corporate bodies possessed of the patronage of ecclesiastical livings or benefices, to advance and lend any sum or sums of money of which they have the power of disposing, in order to aid and assist the several purposes of this Act, for the building, rebuilding, repairing or purchasing of any houses or buildings for the habitation and convenience of the clergy upon livings or benefices under the patronage of such college or hall, [<sup>F13</sup>upon the mortgage and security directed by this Act for the repayment of the principal,] without taking any interest for the same.
