## **PETROLEUM**

## Compressed Gases

THE GAS CYLINDERS (CONVEYANCE) REGULATIONS, 1947\*, DATED JULY 24, 1947, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 6 OF THE PETROLEUM (CONSOLIDATION) ACT, 1928 (18 & 19 GEO. 5. C. 32), AS APPLIED BY THE PETROLEUM (COMPRESSED GASES) ORDER, 1930 (S.R. & O. 1930 No. 34).

In pursuance of the power conferred upon me by section six of the Petroleum (Consolidation) Act, 1928, as applied by the Petroleum (Compressed Gases) Order, 1930(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

- 1. In Regulation 5 of the Gas Cylinders (Conveyance) Regulations, 1931(b) (which provides that the working or internal pressure in any cylinder used for the conveyance by road of certain gases shall not exceed 1.800 lbs. to the square inch), for the words "1,800 lbs." there shall be substituted the words "1,980 lbs.".
- 2. These Regulations may be cited as the Gas Cylinders (Conveyance) Regulations, 1947, and shall come into operation on the first day of August, 1947.
