General powers and directions

13 Delegation

- (1) The Commission may delegate to one or more of its members or an assistant commissioner such of its functions under Chapters 2 to 4, 6 or 7 of Part 3 [^{F1}of this Act] (functions relating to the conduct of reviews of local government or local inquiries)[^{F2}, or Schedule 1 to the Local Government and Elections (Wales) Act 2021 (functions relating to initial reviews),] as it may determine to the extent so delegated.
- (2) Subsection (1) does not affect the Commission's—
- (a) responsibility for exercise of delegated functions, or
 - (b) ability to exercise delegated functions.
