AUTHORISED PERSONS

PROTECTION OF AUTHORISED PERSONS

182^{F1} **Penalty for assaulting authorised person.**

If any person assaults—

- (a) any person exercising any power conferred by this Part; or
- (b) any officer of the Ministry^{F2} . . . whilst doing any thing authorised by any of the provisions of this Act specified in Schedule 6; or
- (c) any authorised officer acting under section 112 or 120, or any officer acting under section 17 or 127;

he shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding [^{F3} £500] or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both such fine and such imprisonment.
