#### 196 False statements in applications: offence

After section 134 of the 2005 Act insert—

##### “134A Offence of knowingly making a false statement in an application

- (1) A person who knowingly makes a false statement in an application under this Act commits an offence.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under subsection (1) is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.”
