Shipbuilding (Reports on Ropes and Rope Slings) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975

Coming into operation . . 15th September 1975 .

The Department(a) of Manpower Services by virtue of section 176(1) of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) and in pursuance of Regulation 36(2) of the Shipbuilding and Ship-repairing Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1971(c) (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations"), the powers under which are now vested in it(d), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

Made

1. This Order may be cited as the Shipbuilding (Reports on Ropes and Rope Slings) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of September 1975.

2. Reports of the results of examinations under Regulation 36(2) of the Regulations shall contain the following particulars:

- (i) the name and address of the owner of the ropes or rope slings and, in the case of a ship not registered in the United Kingdom, of the master or officer in charge;
- (ii) the distinguishing number or mark and a description sufficient to identify the rope or rope sling;
- (iii) the date and number of the certificate of any test and examination in pursuance of Regulation 35 of the Regulations;
- (iv) the date when first taken into use:
- (v) the safe working load;
- (vi) (a) the construction of the rope, including the number of strands and wires per strand excluding filler wires, and of the maximum number of wires broken in any length of ten diameters:
 - (b) any other defects:
- (vii) the name and address of the Public Service, association, company, firm or person carrying out the examination and the date of the examination: and
- (viii) the position in the Public Service, association, company, or firm of the person who carried out the examination or his qualification if he is working on his own account.
