### Shipbuilding (Particulars of Annealing) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975

The Department(a) of Manpower Services by virtue of section 176(1) of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) and in pursuance of Regulation 35(3) of the Shipbuilding and Ship-repairing Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1971(c) (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations"), the powers under which are now vested in it(d), hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Shipbuilding (Particulars of Annealing) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of September 1975.

2. The particulars to be kept under Regulation 35(3) of the Regulations of the annealing of chains and lifting gear made of wrought iron shall be as follows:

- (i) the name and address of the owner of the chain or lifting gear and, in the case of a ship not registered in the United Kingdom, of the master or officer in charge;
- (ii) the distinguishing number or mark and a description sufficient to identify the chain or lifting gear;
- (iii) in the case of a chain, the nominal size of the wrought iron bar from which the links are made;
- (iv) the date of annealing;
- (v) the temperature at which annealing was carried out;
- (vi) the method of carrying out the annealing (that is to say, the type of furnace or oven employed, whether cooled in still air or otherwise after withdrawal from the furnace etc.);
- (vii) any defects found after annealing;
- (viii) the name and address of the Public Service, association, company, firm or person carrying out the annealing;
  - (ix) the position in the Public Service, association, company or firm of the person who carried out the annealing or his qualification if he is working on his own account; and
  - (x) the steps taken to remedy the defects (if any) specified in (vii).

## EXPLANATORY NOTE
