PART 12

MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

Documents issuing from Department

12.07.—(1) Any document purporting to be, or to contain, any order, directions or certificate issued by the Department shall be received in evidence and deemed to be or (as the case may be) contain that order or certificate, or those directions, without further proof, unless the contrary is shown.

(2) Without prejudice to the foregoing, a certificate by the Department confirming—

- (a) the making of any order,
- (b) the issuing of any document, or
- (c) the exercise of any discretion, power or obligation arising or imposed under the Order or the Rules,

is conclusive evidence of the matters dealt with in the certificate.
