**Poultry Laying Flocks (Registration and Testing etc.)  
(Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993**

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st June 1993

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 5(1), 44 and 60(1) of the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Poultry Laying Flocks (Registration and Testing etc.) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1993.

*Revocation*

2. The Poultry Laying Flocks (Registration and Testing etc.) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990(b) is hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order revokes the Poultry Laying Flocks (Registration and Testing etc.) Order (Northern Ireland) 1990 which provided for the testing for the presence of salmonella in certain samples and the registration of flocks of domestic fowls kept for the production of eggs for human consumption. It also provided for various requirements relating to the collection and handling of eggs from such flocks, the control of vermin and the keeping of certain records in relation to samples, results of tests and the movement of poultry.
