ORDER IN COUNCIL, DATED THE 8TH DAY OF JULY 1966, MAKING REGULATIONS REVOKING THE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966(a).

BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND

ERSKINE OF RERRICK

Whereas a Proclamation has been made revoking the Proclamation of Emergency made on 26th May 1966, under section 1 of the Emergency Powers Act (Northern Ireland) 1926(b), as amended by the Emergency Powers (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(c):

And whereas in pursuance of section 2 of the said Act of 1926 Regulations entitled the Emergency Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 were made by Order in Council dated the 26th May 1966:

And whereas it is expedient that those Regulations should be revoked:

Now, therefore, I, John Maxwell, Baron Erskine of Rerrick, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor of Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the said section 2, and of all other powers me thereunto enabling, do, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, by this Order make the following Regulations:—

Revocation

1. The Emergency Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 are hereby revoked.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966.

ROAD TRAFFIC**Speed Limits**

ORDER*, DATED 6TH JUNE, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 23(4) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1955.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23(4) of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1955(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966 and shall come into operation on 4th July, 1966.

Revocation of Previous Order and Directions

2. The Roads (Sydenham By-Pass Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 1961(b), and the directions contained in the Roads (Speed Limit) Order
