Seed Potato Improvement Scheme

SCHEME, DATED 7TH MAY 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE AGRICULTURE (TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1954, AS AMENDED BY SECTION I OF THE AGRICULTURE (TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE) (AMENDMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1957.

The Minister of Agriculture, with the approval of the Minister of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Acts (Northern Ireland) 1954 and 1957(a) and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby makes the following Scheme:—

Short Title and Commencement

1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Seed Potato (Improvement) (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1969.

(2) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 7th day of May 1969.

Amendment of the Principal Scheme

2. In Article 6(3) of the Seed Potato (Improvement) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) for “£50,000” there shall be substituted “£65,000”.
