ARMS AND AMMUNITION**Firearms (Prescribed Forms)**

REGULATIONS, DATED 14TH FEBRUARY 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTIONS 1(1), 4(1), 13(1), 13(2), 15(2) AND 31 OF THE FIREARMS (AMENDMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1968.

I, Captain the Right Honourable William Joseph Long, Minister of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 1(1), 4(1), 13(1), 13(2), 15(2) and 31 of the Firearms (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms (Prescribed Forms) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1969.

2. In these Regulations—

“the Act” means the Firearms (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1968.

3. An application under section 1(1) of the Act for the grant or renewal of a firearm certificate or firearm permit shall be in the form set out in Part I of the Schedule.

4. A permit under section 4(1) of the Act authorising the removal of a firearm from or to a ship, or of a signalling apparatus from or to an aircraft or aerodrome, shall be in the form set out in Part II of the Schedule.

5. A permit under section 13(1) of the Act authorising an auctioneer to sell by auction, expose for sale by auction, or have in his possession for sale by auction, firearms or ammunition without being registered as a firearms dealer, and the conditions which may be attached to such permit under section 13(2) of the Act, shall be in the form set out in Part III of the Schedule.

6. The particulars to be furnished under section 15(2) of the Act by every person registered as a firearms dealer in any area who proposes to carry on business as such at any place of business in that area which is not entered in the register shall be as set out in Part IV of the Schedule.

PART III

Regulation 5

PERMIT FOR AN AUCTIONEER

to sell by auction, expose for sale by auction, and have in his possession for sale by auction a firearm or ammunition

Permission is hereby granted to the auctioneer(s)

to have in possession for sale by auction and to expose for sale by auction the following firearms and ammunition:--

FIREARMS (Description, including type, calibre, maker's name, identification number or other distinguishing mark).

AMMUNITION (Quantity, type and calibre)

and to sell them by auction in the police area named below on the terms that:--

- (1) The person to whom this permit is granted shall inform the County Inspector forthwith of the name and address of any person purchasing any of the above firearms or ammunition.
(2) Such precautions as the County Inspector may direct shall be taken to ensure the safe custody of the firearms and ammunition, and any loss or theft shall be reported at once to the County Inspector.
(3) This permit shall be returned to the County Inspector on the date on which it expires, or as soon as the firearms and ammunition to which it relates have been disposed of, whichever date is the earlier.

This permit expires on County Inspector for the Police Area of the County/City of Date

PART IV

Regulation 6

The particulars to be furnished to the County Inspector for a police area by a firearms dealer who, being registered as a firearms dealer in that area, proposes to carry on business as a firearms dealer at a place of business in that area which is not entered in the register of firearms dealers shall be:—

Name of firearms dealer in full.

Place of business.

Address of proposed place of business as a firearms dealer and name under which the business will be carried on.

Nature of the firearms business to be carried on at the proposed address, i.e., whether manufacture, repair, test or proof, or sale, wholesale or retail, or hire, and whether the business will be confined to any particular type of firearm or ammunition.

Other business, if any, which will be carried on by the firearms dealer or any other person at the proposed address and the name under which such business will be carried on.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations set out—

- (a) the form in which an application is to be made for the grant or renewal of a firearm certificate or permit;
- (b) the form of a permit authorising the removal of a firearm from or to a ship, or of a signalling apparatus from or to an aircraft or aerodrome;
- (c) the form of a permit (or the conditions attached thereto) authorising an auctioneer to sell, etc., any firearms or ammunition without being registered as a firearms dealer; and
- (d) the particulars to be furnished by a firearms dealer who proposes to open additional premises in an area.
