EMERGENCY POWERS

ORDER IN COUNCIL, DATED THE 15TH DAY OF DECEMBER 1970, MAKING REGULATIONS REVOKING THE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1970.

BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND

GREY OF NAUNTON

WHEREAS a Proclamation has been made revoking the Proclamation of Emergency made on 7th December 1970, under section 1 of the Emergency Powers Act (Northern Ireland) 1926(a), as amended by the Emergency Powers (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(b):

AND WHEREAS in pursuance of section 2 of the said Act of 1926 Regulations entitled the Emergency Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970(c) were made by Order in Council dated the 7th December 1970.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that those Regulations should be revoked:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RALPH FRANCIS ALNWICK, BARON GREY OF NAUNTON, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Officer of the Order of the British Empire, Governor of Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the said section 2, and of all other powers me thereunto enabling, do, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, by this Order make the following Regulations:—

Revocation

1. The Emergency Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970 are hereby revoked.

Short title

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970.
