### **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A80 Trunk Road (Stepps to Haggs) (Temporary 40mph Speed Restriction) Order 2009

Coming into force

18th February 2009 25th February 2009

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1) and (4), 2(1) and 2(2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

# Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A80 Trunk Road (Stepps to Haggs) (Temporary 40mph Speed Restriction) Order 2009, comes into force on 25th February 2009 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 22nd August 2010.

# **Temporary speed restriction**

2. No person shall drive any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 40mph when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations(a).

# **SCHEDULE**

- 1. That length of the A80 Glasgow-Stirling Trunk Road being the westbound carriageway from Junction 4 Haggs to Hornshill Farm, a distance of 21.6 kilometres or thereby.
- 2. That length of the A80 Glasgow-Stirling Trunk Road being the eastbound carriageway from the junction at Hornshill Farm to Junction 4 Haggs, a distance of 21.6 kilometres or thereby.
- 3. That length of the M73 Trunk Road from its junction (Junction 3) with the A80 Glasgow-Stirling Trunk Road to a point 1060 metres from the junction, a distance of 1060 metres or thereby.
