Amendment of the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) (Scotland) Order 1997

- **13.**—(1) The Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) (Scotland) Order 1997(1) is amended in accordance with paragraphs 2 and 3.
- (2) In article 3(6) (use classes) in the definition of "pay day loan shop", for "class 2 (financial, professional and other services)" substitute "paragraph (2) of class 1A (financial, professional and other services)".
 - (3) In the schedule—
 - (a) for paragraphs 1 (Class 1. Shops) and 2 (Class 2. Financial, professional and other services) substitute—

"Shops and financial, professional and other services

Class

1A.—(1) Use—

- (a) for the retail sale of goods other than hot food,
- (b) as a post office,
- (c) for the sale of tickets,
- (d) as a travel agency,
- (e) for the sale of cold food for consumption off the premises,
- (f) for hairdressing,
- (g) for the direction of funerals,
- (h) for the display of goods for sale,
- (i) for the hiring out of domestic or personal goods or articles,
- (j) as a laundrette or dry cleaners,
- (k) for the reception of goods to be washed, cleaned or repaired,

where the sale, display or service is principally to visiting members of the public.

- (2) Use for the provision of—
 - (a) financial services,

- (b) professional services,
- (c) any other services,

which it is appropriate to provide in a shopping area and where the sale, display or service is principally to visiting members of the public.", and

(b) in paragraph 4 (class 4. Business), for "class 2 (financial, professional and other services)" substitute "paragraph 2 of class 1A (financial, professional and other services)".
