



**CHAPTER clxviii.**

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order under the Land Drainage Act 1861 in the matter of a proposed drainage district in the Parishes of Above Derwent Underskiddaw Embleton Wythop Setmurthy Isel Old Park and Bassenthwaite in the County of Cumberland. A.D. 1913.

[14th February 1913.]

**W**HEREAS the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries have made the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Land Drainage Act 1861: 24 & 25 Vict.  
c. 133.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Order as set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Order in

2. This Act may be cited as the Land Drainage (Braithwaite Moss) Provisional Order Confirmation Act 1912. Short title.

SCHEDULE.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1861.

PROVISIONAL ORDER.

*In the matter of a proposed Drainage District in the Parishes  
of Above Derwent Underskiddaw Embleton Wythop  
Setmurthy Isel Old Park and Bassenthwaite  
in the County of Cumberland.*

1. The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries in pursuance of the powers vested in them by the Land Drainage Act 1861 and the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries Acts 1889 to 1909 do by this Provisional Order constitute the lands shown on a plan sealed by the Board and therein coloured red and yellow a separate drainage district under the Land Drainage Act 1861.

2. And they do further by this their Provisional Order make the following regulations with respect to the Drainage Board (that is to say):—

- (a) The Drainage Board for the said district shall consist of twelve members:
- (b) The following persons shall be the members of the first Drainage Board:—

Joseph Broatch of Court Buildings Keswick in the County of Cumberland;

Edward Hughes Dodgson of Derwent House Cocker-  
mouth in the said county;

Joseph Fisher of The Higham near Cocker-  
mouth aforesaid;

Simon Fraser of Hutton in the Forest Penrith in the  
said county;

Joseph Simpson Harker of Brooklands Penrith aforesaid;

Jonathan Harryman of Portinscale Keswick aforesaid;

Joseph Litt of Thornthwaite Keswick aforesaid;

George Richardson of the City of Carlisle in the said A.D. 1913.

- (c) The first meeting of the Drainage Board shall be summoned by a notice under the hands of any two or more members of the Drainage Board which shall be published in some newspaper circulating extensively in the said district and shall be posted at the principal entrance doors of the places of public worship or at other places where notices are usually exhibited in the said parishes of Above Derwent Under-skiddaw Embleton Wythop Setmurthy Isel Old Park and Bassenthwaite at least fourteen days before the day of meeting :
- (d) The qualification of any subsequent member of the Drainage Board shall be that he shall be (1) the proprietor of not less than ten acres of land within the said district or (2) the heir apparent of a proprietor (such proprietor not being himself a member of the Board) of not less than ten acres of land within the said district or (3) the occupying tenant yearly or otherwise of not less than twenty acres of land within the same district or (4) the agent of a proprietor of not less than ten acres of land within the said district such agent acting under a written appointment and his principal not being a member of the Board :
- (e) The members of the first Drainage Board shall vacate their offices on the first Thursday in September in the year following that in which this Provisional Order shall have been confirmed by Parliament :
- (f) The electors for members of the Drainage Board shall be the persons who were during the year immediately preceding such election liable to be rated to any drainage rate of the said district leviable by the Drainage Board and have paid all such rates (if any) levied and due from them at the time of such election.

3. The lands coloured yellow on the said sealed plan shall not be liable to be rated by the Drainage Board in respect of any works executed by the Board for the exclusive benefit of the lands coloured

A.D. 1913. — red on the said plan and the said lands coloured red shall not be liable to be rated in respect of any works executed by the Board for the exclusive benefit of the said lands coloured yellow but any part of the said lands coloured yellow or of the said lands coloured red shall be liable to be so rated in respect of any works executed by the Board from which such part derives benefit.
