An Act to confirm a Provisional Order made by the Local A.D. 1896.

Government Board for Ireland under the Public Health
(Ireland) Act 1878 relating to the Rural Sanitary
District of Listowel. [7th August 1896.]

WHEREAS the Local Government Board for Ireland have made the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereto under the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878:

And whereas it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Order set out in the schedule hereto is hereby confirmed Order in and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force.

GLIN DISTRICT SCHOOL WATERWORKS.

PROVISIONAL ORDER.

WHEREAS by an order of the Local Government Board for Ireland (herein-after called the Local Government Board) dated the twenty-seventh of February one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three the Poor Law Unions of Croom Kilmallock Limerick Listowel Newcastle and Rathkeale were combined for the purpose of establishing a joint school for the maintenance and education of children not above the age of fifteen years and a board of management was constituted for the conduct of the said school:

And whereas in pursuance of the said order a joint school called the Glin D strict School has been established at Glin in the rural sanitary district consisting of the Listowel Poor Law Union and it has become necessary to procure a supply of water for the said school and for that purpose that the guardians of the poor of the Listowel poor law union (herein-after called the sanitary authority) shall be given compulsory powers of purchasing lands and other premises required for the purposes of executing the works required for supplying water to the said school and the sanitary authority have presented a petition to the Local Government Board praying that they may be empowered to put in force the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement with reference to certain lands and premises required for the purposes aforesaid and have deposited at the office of the Local Government Board in Dublin plans and a book of reference (herein-after called the deposited plans and book of reference) showing the lands and premises required for the said purposes:

And whereas by an Order of the Local Government Board made in

pursuance of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 the part of the townland of

Ballygiltenan North in the barony of Shanid parish of Kilfergus and county

of Limerick wherein are situate the Glin District School and its appurtenances

and the lands and premises occupied therewith for the purposes of the said school has been constituted a separate contributory place to be supplied with water by the sanitary authority in pursuance of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 and the guardians of the poor of the said several unions (herein-after

called the contributory boards of guardians) have by articles of agreement under their respective seals contracted and agreed that the guardians of the poor of each of the said unions shall contribute to the expenses of and incidental

to obtaining the said water supply in the manner herein-after mentioned:

And whereas all advertisements and notices required by the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 having been published served and given the Local Government Board have caused a local inquiry to be held as to the propriety

of assenting to the prayer of the petition of the sanitary authority and it appears to be proper to make this order with respect to the matters aforesaid:

Listowel.

It is ordered by the Local Government Board as follows:—

1. From and after the confirmation of this Order by Parliament the sanitary authority shall be empowered to put in force the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement with reference to the lands lands covered with water rights to take and convey water easements and other premises shown in the deposited plan and book of reference (excluding a piece of land in the townland of Kinard parish of Kilfergus and Country Limerick numbered 5 in the deposited plan and book of reference and therein described as site of reservoir but including the site for the pipe line running through and across the site of reservoir) and the word "land" in the Lands Clauses Acts shall for the purposes of this Order extend to and include the said lands lands covered with water rights to take and convey water easements and other premises.

Compulsory powers of putchasing lands and other premises.

2. The powers of compulsory purchase given by this Order shall not be Duration of exercised after the expiration of three years from the confirmation of compulsory this Order.

3. The contributory boards of guardians shall contribute to and pay the Expenses of expenses of and incidental to the application for and confirmation of Order. this Order and the execution thereof and the purchase money of the lands and premises aforesaid and the execution and maintenance of the proposed works in the manner provided by the said articles of agreement and each contributory board of guardians accordingly shall contribute to the said expenses in the same proportions and in the same manner as they are bound to contribute to the local establishment expenses of the Glin District School according to the provisions of the said Order of the 27th February 1893.

4. This Order may be cited and referred to for all purposes as the Glin Short title of District School (Waterworks) Provisional Order 1896.
