

### CHAPTER clxviii.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Local A.D. 1896. Government Board relating to the Urban District of Blackpool and the Rural Districts of Chelmsford Martley and South Mimms. 7th August 1896.

WHEREAS the Local Government Board have made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875:

38 & 39 Viet.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament and that the provision herein contained should be enacted with reference thereto:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Orders as altered and set out in the schedule hereto shall Orders in be and the same are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof schedule shall have full validity and force.

2. The district councils mentioned in the Orders hereby confirmed Special shall not under the powers of those Orders purchase or acquire provision as either compulsorily or by agreement ten or more houses which on labouring the fifteenth day of December last were occupied either wholly or class. partially by persons belonging to the labouring class as tenants or lodgers or except with the consent of the Local Government Board ten or more houses which were not so occupied on the said fifteenth day of December but have been or shall be subsequently so occupied.

For the purposes of this section the expression "labouring class" includes mechanics artizans labourers and others working for

#### BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL.

Blackpool Order.

Provisional Order to enable the Urban District Council for the Borough of Blackpool to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts.

To the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Blackpool;— And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Blackpool acting by the Council as the Urban District Council for that Borough (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") require to purchase and take the lands situate in the Borough and which are described in the Schedule hereto for the following purposes viz.,—

- 1. The lands mentioned in Part I. of the said Schedule for the purpose of widening a street called Station Road;
- 2. The lands mentioned in Part II. of the said Schedule for the purpose of opening and extending Shaw Road to the Carriage Drive and widening Victoria Street South Shore;
- 3. The lands mentioned in Part III. of the said Schedule for the purpose of widening a street called New Road:

And whereas by the Blackpool Order 1894 which was confirmed by the Local 57 & 58 Vict. Government Board's Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 14) Act 1894 the c. exxix. Corporation were empowered to put in force with reference to parts of the lands numbered 123 and 7 in Part II. of the Schedule hereto the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them:

Now therefore We the Local Government Board in pursuance of the powers given to Us by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and by any other 38 & 39 Vict. Statutes in that behalf do hereby Order that from and after the date of the c. 55. Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect viz.,—

Art. I. The Corporation shall be empowered to put in force with reference to the lands described in the Schedule hereto subject to the continuance of any existing public rights of highway and for the purposes aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them:

Provided that the powers conferred upon the Corporation by the Blackpool Order 1894 as regards the parts of the lands numbered 1 2 3 and 7 in Part II. of the Schedule hereto shall from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order absolutely cease and determine except so far as they may have been acted upon.

Art. II. This Order may be cited as the Blackpool Order 1896.
