

CHAPTER ix.

An Act to extend the time for the sale of superfluous A.D. 1896. lands of the Millwall Dock Company. [21st May 1896.]

WHEREAS by the Millwall Dock Act 1879 (herein-after called "the Act of 1879") the Millwall Dock Act 1879 (herein-after called "the Act of 1879") the Millwall Dock Company (hereinafter called "the Company") were empowered to retain and hold for a period of ten years from the passing of that Act any lands purchased or acquired by them and which but for that Act they. might be bound to sell or dispose of as superfluous before the expiration of that period:

And whereas by the Millwall Dock Act 1887 (herein-after called "the Act of 1887") the said period was extended for a further period of seven years:

And whereas it is expedient that such period should be further extended:

And whereas the object aforesaid cannot be attained without the authority of Parliament:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Millwall Dock Act 1896.

Short title.

2. The time limited by the Act of 1879 as amended by the Act Extending of 1887 for the sale of lands which may become superfluous to the time for sale Company's undertaking is hereby extended for a further period of fluous lands. ten years to be computed from the expiration of the period limited by the Act of 1879 as amended by the Act of 1887.

3. The costs charges and expenses of applying for obtaining and Costs of Act. passing this Act shall be paid by the Company.
