



CHAPTER 19.

An Act to renew the Education Act, 1901.

[31st July 1902.]

A.D. 1902.

BE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1. The Education Act, 1901, shall have effect, as respects the year ending the thirty-first day of July one thousand nine hundred and three, as if "one thousand nine hundred and two" were substituted for "one thousand nine hundred and one" in section one of that Act. Renewal of Education Act, 1901.

2. This Act may be cited as the Education Act, 1901, (Renewal) Act, 1902. Short title.
