Licensing System

6 Licensing structure

- (1) The Secretary of State may by order provide for Schedule 1 (which amends the licensing structure of the National Lottery) to have effect.
- (2) Before making an order under subsection (1) the Secretary of State must consult the [^{F1}Gambling] Commission.
- (3) An order under subsection (1)—
 - (a) may make transitional or incidental provision,
 - (b) may bring all or part of Schedule 1 into force,
 - (c) may make different provision for different purposes,
 - (d) shall be made by statutory instrument, and
 - (e) shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
