PART 6

MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL PROVISIONS

General provisions

95 Power to make consequential amendments

- (1) The Secretary of State may by regulations make provision that is consequential on any provision of this Act.
- (2) The provision that may be made by regulations under subsection (1) includes provision amending primary legislation.
- (3) "Primary legislation" means—
 - (a) an Act of Parliament,
 - (b) a Measure or Act of Senedd Cymru,
 - (c) an Act of the Scottish Parliament,
 - (d) Northern Ireland legislation, or
 - (e) retained direct principal EU legislation,

whenever passed or made.
