PART IV.—EXECUTION OF THE CONVENTION

SECTION II.—FINAL PROVISIONS

ARTICLE 156

Accessions shall be notified in writing to the Swiss Federal Council, and shall take effect six months after the date on which they are received.

The Swiss Federal Council shall communicate the accession to all the Powers in whose name the Convention has been signed, or whose accession has been notified.
