CHAPTER 82

CLERK OF THE PARLIAMENTS ACT 1824

- Clerk Assistant to be Clerk of the Parliaments, upon Expiration of Letters Patent.
- II Clerk of the Parliaments to be appointed by His Majesty, and to execute Duties in Person.
 - III Appointment of other Clerks officiating at the Table vested in the Lord Chancellor.
 - IV Sir George Henry Rose to appoint to any one of the said Offices for one Turn only.
 - V Other Clerks to be appointed by Clerk Assistant during Existence of present Letters Patent.
 - VI This Act not to interfere with Rights, Profits, &c. of Sir *George Henry Rose*, and *Henry Cowper*, Esq. except as herein provided. During present Letters of Patent the Clerk Assistant to be appointed by the Crown.
