1 Short title.

This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Metropolitan Streets Act, 1867."

3 Definitions:

The following expressions for the purposes of this Act shall, unless the context requires a different construction, have the meanings herein-after assigned to them; that is to say,

"Commissioner of Police," beyond the limits of the City of London . . . ^{F3}, shall mean "the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis," and within such limits "the Commissioner of the Police Force of the City of London . . . ^{F3}."

"Street" shall include any highway or other public place, whether a thoroughfare or not; and any of the royal parks, gardens, and possessions which are managed by the Commissioners of Works in pursuance of the ^{MI}Crown Lands Acts, 1851, shall, for the purposes of this Act, be deemed to be public places:

- [^{F4}"the limits of this Act" means—
- (a) the City of London;
- (b) the area enclosed in a circle of which the centre is Charing Cross, and the radii are six miles in length as measured in a straight line from Charing Cross.]
