EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation on 17th December 1969 all the provisions of the Police Act 1969 with the exception of those of section 1(1), (2) and (3) (aid by home police forces of the Royal Ulster Constabulary), section 3 (aid given to a home police force by the Royal Ulster Constabulary) and section 4 (Police Council for the United Kingdom).
