The Police Cadets (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1969

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 35 of the Police Act 1964(a), and after consulting the Police Council for Great Britain in accord-

ance with section 45(4) of that Act, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

Coming into Operation

Citation and operation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1970.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets Regulations 1968(b), as amended(c).

Pay

3. For the Table in Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations (which, as set out in Regulation 3 of the Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations 1969(c), contains scales of pay) there shall be substituted the following Table:—

Charge for board and lodging

- 4. For paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations (which, as set out in Regulation 4 of the said Regulations of 1969, relates to charges for board and lodging) there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—
 - "2. The annual rate of charge shall be-
 - (a) in the case of a police cadet attached to the City of London or metropolitan police force, £105;
 - (b) in any other case, £96.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Cadets Regulations 1968.

Regulation 3 increases the pay of a police cadet by amounts which vary according to his age.

Regulation 4 increases charges payable by police cadets for board and lodging by £1 10s. 0d. a year in the case of cadets attached to the City of London or metropolitan police force and £2 10s. 0d. in the case of other cadets.

The Regulations come into operation on 1st January 1970.
