The Import Duties (General) (No. 5) Order 1969

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>15th December 1969</i>
<i>Laid before the House of Commons - - -</i>	<i>18th December 1969</i>
<i>Coming into Operation -</i>	<i>1st January 1970</i>

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Board of Trade hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (General) (No. 5) Order 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 1st January 1970.

2. In Schedule 1 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 3) Order 1969(c) (which Schedule by reference to the Customs Tariff 1959 sets out the import duties chargeable under the Import Duties Act 1958), in heading 03.01 (fish, fresh (live or dead), chilled or frozen) the rate of duty shown in column 3 against sub-heading (C)(1) and prefixed by the letter "E" shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order removes the import duty on imports from the European Free Trade Area of chilled or frozen fish fillets and of certain chilled or frozen portions prepared by cutting blocks of fillets.
