The Superannuation (Teaching and Public Boards) Interchange (Scotland) Amendment Rules 1970

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 2 and 15 of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act $1948(\mathbf{a})$, as amended by section 11 of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act $1967(\mathbf{b})$ and as read with the Minister for the Civil Service Order $1968(\mathbf{c})$, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and with the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service, I hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Superannuation (Teaching and Public Boards) Interchange (Scotland) Amendment Rules 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1970.

2. Schedule 3 to the Superannuation (Teaching and Public Boards) Interchange (Scotland) Rules 1969(d) is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following bodies and dates :---

The Meat and Livestock Commission—1st October 1968.

The Post Office-1st October 1969.

3. In relation to a person becoming, or ceasing to be, employed by a body added to Schedule 3 to the Superannuation (Teaching and Public Boards) Interchange (Scotland) Rules 1969 by rule 2 the operative date for the purposes of those rules shall be the date of the coming into operation of these rules.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules extend to the Meat and Livestock Commission and the Post Office the existing arrangements under the Superannuation (Teaching and Public Boards) Interchange (Scotland) Rules 1969 for the preservation of superannuation rights upon changes of employment between teaching and public boards.

In accordance with section 2(5) of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1948 the Rules therefore apply subject to certain conditions to persons who have transferred from one employment to the other before the coming into operation of the Rules.
