**The National Insurance (Members of the Forces) Amendment
Regulations 1971**

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of his powers under sections 4(6) and (7) of the National Insurance Act 1965(a), and the National Insurance Joint Authority, in conjunction with the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 99 of that Act (as extended by section 1(1) of and paragraph 9 of Schedule 1 to the National Insurance Act 1966(b)), in each case in exercise of all other powers enabling him or them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations, which contain no provisions other than such as are made in consequence of the National Insurance Act 1971(c) and which accordingly by virtue of section 16(3) of and paragraph 2(1)(a) of Schedule 6 to that Act are exempt from the requirements of section 108 of the said Act of 1965 (reference to the National Insurance Advisory Committee):—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the National Insurance (Members of the Forces) Amendment Regulations 1971, shall be read as one with the National Insurance (Members of the Forces) Regulations 1968(d), as amended (e) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”), and shall come into operation in the case of regulations 1 and 2(1) on 20th September 1971 and in the case of regulation 2(2) on 21st September 1971.

Amendment of Schedules 3, 4, 5 and 5A to the principal regulations

2.—(1) For the table set out in Schedule 3 (reduction of weekly rates of flat-rate contributions) to the principal regulations there shall be substituted the table set out in Schedule A to these regulations.

(2) For the tables set out in Schedules 4 (statutory provisions applying to graduated contributions which are modified in their application to employment as a serving member of the forces), 5 (scale of graduated contributions in respect of employment which is not a non-participating employment) and 5A (scale of graduated contributions in respect of non-participating employ-

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations contain no provisions other than such as are made in consequence of the National Insurance Act 1971 and accordingly they are, by virtue of section 16(3) of and paragraph 2 of Schedule 6 to that Act, exempt from reference to the National Insurance Advisory Committee and no such reference has been made.

The Regulations amend the provisions of the National Insurance (Members of the Forces) Regulations 1968 relating to flat-rate and graduated contributions payable by serving members of the forces and substitute new tables prescribing the rates of graduated contributions payable from 21st September 1971 and the reduction in the flat-rate contributions payable from 20th September 1971.
