The Tokyo Convention (Certification of Countries) Order 1971*Made - - - - 22nd December 1971*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 22nd day of December 1971

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 7(1) of the Tokyo Convention Act 1967(a) (which provides that Her Majesty may by Order in Council certify which countries are Convention countries, that is to say countries in which the Convention on Offences and certain other Acts Committed on board Aircraft signed in Tokyo on 14th September 1963 is for the time being in force) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Tokyo Convention (Certification of Countries) Order 1971.

2. The Tokyo Convention (Certification of Countries) Order 1970(b) is hereby revoked. Section 38(2) of the Interpretation Act 1889(c) (which relates to the effect of repeals) shall apply to this Order as if this Order were an Act of Parliament and as if the Order revoked by this Article were an Act of Parliament thereby repealed.

3. It is hereby certified that the countries listed in the Schedule hereto are Convention countries.

Under section 7(1) of the Tokyo Convention Act 1967 this Order is conclusive evidence of the matters certified.
