Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1) 1972

Made - - - 9th February 1972 Coming into Operation 9th March 1972

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 16 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(a) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:

- 1. Rule 158 of the Rules of Court(b) is hereby amended by adding at the end of paragraph (b) thereof the words: "Provided that in any application under this paragraph the Court may make such interim orders as it may think proper."
- 2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1) 1972, and shall come into operation on 9th March 1972.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.
