**The Registration of Restrictive Trading Agreements (Fees)
Regulations 1972**

The Registrar of Restrictive Trading Agreements (in these Regulations referred to as "the Registrar") in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11 and 19 of the Restrictive Trade Practices Act 1956(a) hereby orders, with the approval of the Treasury, that the following Regulations shall have effect:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Registration of Restrictive Trading Agreements (Fees) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on 27th March 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) The Registration of Restrictive Trading Agreements (Fees) Regulations 1956(c) are hereby revoked.

2. The fee to be paid to the Registrar in respect of the inspection of the register by any person on any day shall be 50p but if less than five agreements particulars of which are entered or filed therein are so inspected the fee shall be 10p for each of such agreements.

3. The fee to be paid to the Registrar in respect of the supply of each copy of, or extract from, any particulars entered or filed in the register, otherwise than in the special section, certified by the Registrar to be a true copy or extract shall be:—

(a) where the sheet or sheets copied or from which the extract is made do not exceed in area foolscap size—10p in respect of each such sheet;

(b) where the sheet or sheets copied or from which the extract is made exceed in area foolscap size—20p in respect of each such sheet.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
