WATER SUPPLY, ENGLAND AND WALES

The East Anglian (Syleham) Water Order 1974

Made - - - 14th February 1974

Coming into Operation 1st March 1974

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the East Anglian (Syleham) Water Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1974. Citation and commencement.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the East Anglian Water Acts and Orders 1853 to 1974.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

“the Company” means the East Anglian Water Company;

“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

“the undertaking” means the undertaking of the Company as from time to time authorised by any enactment;

and any expression to which a meaning is assigned by the Third Schedule shall have the meaning so assigned. Interpretation.

3.—(1) The Company may construct and maintain, on the land belonging to the Company and described in Schedule 1 to this order, a borehole and (in addition to the works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order) pumping stations and all such wells, boreholes, adits and other headings as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting or improving the supply of water obtainable by means of the said borehole. Power to construct works.

(2) The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes be deemed to form part of the undertaking.

4. For the purposes of this order the provisions of the Third Schedule which are set out in column (1) of Schedule 2 to this order shall, subject to the modifications set out in column (2) thereof, apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order. Application and incorporation of certain provisions of Third Schedule.

SCHEDULE 1

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

Land at Syleham in the parish of Syleham in the rural district of Hartismere in the county of East Suffolk, comprising 14,625 square yards or thereabouts and being enclosure 206 on the 1/2500 ordnance map of Suffolk (East), sheet XXVI 6 (edition of 1904).
