The Trunk Road (Colchester Road, Harold Wood) (Prescribed Route) (No. 2) Order 1976

9th June 1976

Coming into Operation

14th June 1976

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a), as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b) and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974(c), and now vested in him (d), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Secretary of State for the Home Department, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (Colchester Road, Harold Wood) (Prescribed Route) (No. 2) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 14th June 1976.
- 2.—(1) In this Order "Colchester Road" means that length of the London-Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (A12) in the London Borough of Havering known as Colchester Road.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle travelling in a north-easterly direction in Colchester Road to turn right into Avenue Road.
- 4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden.
