**The South West Water Authority (Plymouth)  
(Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976**

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the South West Water Authority (Plymouth) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1976.

2. The byelaws made on 7th July 1965 by the lord mayor, aldermen and citizens of the city of Plymouth acting by the council under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the South West Water Authority (Plymouth) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1975(c), remain in force until 6th July 1976, shall remain in force until 6th July 1978.
