**The Felixstowe-Weedon Trunk Road  
(Felixstowe Road (Part) and Other Roads, Ipswich, Trunking)  
Order 1976**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	15th June 1976
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	23rd July 1976

The Secretary of State for the Environment makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 7 of the Highways Act 1959(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The highways described in the Schedule to this Order shall become trunk roads as from the date when this Order comes into operation.

2. In this Order:—

“the deposited plan” means the plan numbered HA7/2—E100 marked “The Felixstowe-Weedon Trunk Road (Felixstowe Road (Part) and Other Roads, Ipswich, Trunking) Order 1976” signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of the Environment, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London SE1, where it may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours;

“the Trunk Road” means the Felixstowe-Weedon Trunk Road (A45).

3. This Order shall come into operation on 23rd July 1976 and may be cited as the Felixstowe-Weedon Trunk Road (Felixstowe Road (Part) and Other Roads, Ipswich, Trunking) Order 1976.

## SCHEDULE

### HIGHWAYS TO BECOME TRUNK ROADS

The highways to become trunk roads are shown on the deposited plan by striped hatching and are:—

- (a) Felixstowe Road from the District Council boundary to its junction with Bucklesham Road.
- (b) Bixley Road.
- (c) Heath Road.
