The City of Manchester (Variation of Licensing and Registration Fees) Order 1978

Made--8th June 1978Laid before Parliament19th June 1978Coming into Operation1st September 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 43 of, and Schedule 1 to, the Manchester Corporation Act 1967(a), as amended by section 23(3) of the Manchester Corporation (General Powers) Act 1971(b), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the City of Manchester (Variation of Licensing and Registration Fees) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1978.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The enactments specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to fees or maximum fees in respect of the matters mentioned in the second column of that Schedule) shall be amended by substituting for the references in those enactments to the sums specified in the third column of that Schedule references to the sums specified in the fourth column thereof, respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the provisions of three local Acts in force in the metropolitan district of Manchester so as to increase the fees or maximum fees which the Manchester City Council may charge under those provisions in respect of the licensing of brokers and dealers in secondhand goods, the registration of entertainment clubs and the licensing and registration of street trading. The new fees are set out in the Schedule to the Order.
