# The City of Glasgow District Council (Common Lodging-Houses) (Charges) Order 1979

Made	5th July 1979
Laid before Parliament	24th July 1979
Coming into Operation	14th August 1979

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 96(1) of the Glasgow Corporation Consolidation (General Powers) Order Confirmation Act 1960(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—This order may be cited as the City of Glasgow District Council (Common Lodging-Houses) (Charges) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 14th August 1979.

#### Alteration of maximum nightly rate for common lodging-houses

2. Section 96(1) of the Glasgow Corporation Consolidation (General Powers) Order Confirmation Act 1960 as amended(b) (which defines the expression "common lodging-house") shall have effect with the substitution of the words "one pound  $(\pounds 1)$ " for the words "ninety-five pence (95p)" in paragraph (a)(i) thereof.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends as from 14th August 1979 the definition of common lodging-house in the Glasgow Corporation Consolidation (General Powers) Order Confirmation Act 1960 by making it applicable, in that area of Glasgow to which the 1960 Order applies, to a house or part thereof in which any person is lodged at a nightly rate not exceeding one pound (£1) rather than ninety-five pence (95p) as hitherto.
