HIGHWAYS, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A18) (West of Ermine Street) (Detrunking) Order 1982

Made - - - - - 29th March 1982
Coming into Operation 30th April 1982

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 (a), and now vested in him (b) and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The length of trunk road described in the Schedule to this order and shown by a series of dashes on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road as from the date on which this order comes into operation.

2. In this order all measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway; and

(i) “the deposited plan” means the plan numbered HA10-YH78, marked “The Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A18) (West of Ermine Street) (Detrunking) Order 1982” signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY;

(ii) “principal road” as a classification for a highway means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of enactments and instruments which refer to highways classified as principal roads and is also classified for the purpose of every other enactment and instrument which refers to highways classified by the Secretary of State;

(iii) “the trunk road” means the Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A18).

3. This order shall come into operation on 30th April 1982 and may be cited as the Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A18) (West of Ermine Street) (Detrunking) Order 1982.

SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE TRUNK ROAD

That length of the trunk road which commences at the Humberside County Boundary, west of Dirtness Bridge, Isle of Axholme, and terminates at its junction with Ermine Street (Roman Road) south of Broughton (including a short section which lies within the boundaries of South Yorkshire near Hatfield Waste Drain and the four roundabouts in or west of Scunthorpe at the junctions with the M181, B1216, A159 and A1029 respectively) a total distance of approximately 25 kilometres (16 miles).
