The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Scheme in exercise of powers conferred by sections 16, 17 and 19 of the Highways Act 1980(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. For the purpose of connecting the M25 Motorway with the M4 Motorway by means of an interchange system at the place stated in the Schedule hereto, the Secretary of State is authorised to provide along the routes described in the said Schedule special roads for the use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1980.

2. The centre lines of the special roads are indicated by heavy black lines on the deposited plan.

3. The special roads shall become trunk roads on the date when this Scheme comes into operation.

4. In this Scheme:—

"the M25 Motorway"	means the special roads provided in pursuance of the M25 Motorway (Poyle to M4 Section) Scheme 1981(c) and of the M25 Motorway (M4 to A412 Denham Road Section) Scheme 1982(d);
"the M4 Motorway"	means the special roads provided in pursuance of the Chiswick—North of Harmondsworth Special Road Scheme 1960(e) as amended by the Chiswick—North of Harmondsworth Special Road (Amendment) Scheme 1962(f) and the North of

SCHEDULE

THE ROUTES OF THE SPECIAL ROADS

Interchange system between the M25 and M4 Motorways at Thorney in Buckinghamshire.

The routes of the special roads to form this interchange system are four routes which, together with the six routes provided by the M25/M4 Motorways (Thorney Interchange) Connecting Roads Scheme 1981(a) and the two routes provided by the M25 Motorway (M4 to A412 Denham Road Section) Connecting Roads Scheme 1982, connect the northbound and southbound carriageways of the M25 Motorway with the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the M4 Motorway. The centre lines of these special roads are shown on the deposited plan where they are respectively given the reference letters A, D, F and H.
