**The Yorkshire Water Authority (Acquisition of Mains)
Order 1985**

Made - - - - - 30th October 1985

Coming into Operation 4th November 1985

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Yorkshire Water Authority (Acquisition of Mains) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 4th November 1985.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Yorkshire Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1985.

Interpretation

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires —

“the Authority” means the Yorkshire Water Authority;

“the deposited plan” means the plan prepared in duplicate, signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked “Plan referred to in the Yorkshire Water Authority (Acquisition of Mains) Order 1985”, one duplicate of which is deposited and available for inspection at the principal offices of the Authority and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment:

“the specified mains” means the works described in the Schedule to this order;

“the undertaking” means the water undertaking of the Authority as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

Power to acquire, continue and maintain mains

3. The Authority may acquire by agreement and thereafter continue and maintain the specified mains or any part thereof.

Works to form part of undertaking

4. Any part of the specified mains acquired by the Authority in pursuance of this order shall be deemed to form part of the undertaking, and for the purposes of section 19 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 (Power to lay mains) as applied to the undertaking shall be deemed to have been laid or constructed by the Authority for the purpose of giving a general supply of water.

Incorporation of section 94 of Third Schedule

5. For the purpose of this order, section 94 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 (which requires copies of the special Act to be kept by the undertakers in their office, and to be deposited with certain officers) shall apply to the undertaking and is hereby incorporated with this order subject to the modification that in sub-section (1) for the words from "with the clerk of the council" to the end of the subsection there shall be substituted the words "with the council of every county and district affected by the special Act".

SCHEDULE

The mains and pipes owned or utilised by the Secretary of State for Defence and laid in the parish of Barlow in the District of Selby in the County of North Yorkshire to supply water to properties in Park Lane, Park Avenue and Hunters Walk and other properties in that parish, the lines and situation of which are shown approximately on the deposited plan and respectively coloured blue and red together with any apparatus subsidiary or appertaining to those mains or pipes.
