WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES

The York Water Order 1985

Made - - - - - 28th May 1985
Coming into Operation 29th May 1985

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945 (a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the York Water Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 29th May 1985.

(2) The York Water Acts and Orders 1846 to 1980 and this order may be cited together as the York Water Acts and Orders 1846 to 1985.

Additional borrowing powers, dividends, etc.

2.—(1) Section 4(1) (Capital and borrowing powers) of the York Water Order 1973 (c), as amended by section 3(a) of the York Water Order 1979 (d), shall have effect as if, in paragraph (i) of the proviso, for the word “twice” there were substituted the words “three times”.

(2) Section 6 (Maximum rates of dividend) of the York Water Order 1973, as substituted by section 3 of the York Water Order 1980 (e), shall have effect as if for the references to the York Water Order 1980 and to the commencement of that order there were substituted references to this order and to the commencement of this order.

Repeal

3. Section 3(a) (Additional borrowing powers) of the York Water Order 1979 is hereby repealed.

Application of section 94 of Third Schedule to Water Act 1945

4. For the purposes of this order, the provisions of section 94 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 (which requires undertakers to keep a copy of the special Act at their principal office, and to deposit copies with certain officers) shall apply to the undertaking of the York Waterworks Company and are hereby incorporated with this order.
