**Definitions for this Part**

**115.** For the purposes of this Part,

‘new certificate’ means a certificate of registry issued in accordance with these Regulations;  
‘old certificate’ means any certificate of registry, other than a provisional certificate, issued under:—

- (i) the Merchant Shipping Act 1894;
- (ii) the Merchant Shipping Act 1983; or
- (iii) the Merchant Shipping Act 1988.

[<sup>F2</sup>“transitional period” in relation to a ship means the period commencing on 21st March 1994 and ending on the date of expiry of the certificate which is specified in relation to such a ship in the table in regulation 116.]
