**PART XI**

**REGISTRATION OF SMALL SHIPS**

**Supplementary information-production of ship**

**99.**—(1) Where it appears to the Registrar that there is any doubt as to the right of the ship to be registered on Part III of the Register, he may require satisfactory evidence to be produced by the person registered as the owner that the ship is entitled to be so registered.

(2) Such evidence may include the production of the ship for inspection at a place and under such conditions as the Registrar requires; and, if the necessary evidence is not provided within [<sup>F1</sup>1 month] of being so required, he may terminate the registration of the ship.
