**The Welsh Language (Names for Police  
Authorities in Wales) Order 1994**

*Made* - - - - *24th October 1994*  
*Laid before Parliament* *27th October 1994*  
*Coming into force* - - *21st November 1994*

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 25 and 27(4)(b) of the Welsh Language Act 1993<sup>(1)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Welsh Language (Names for Police Authorities in Wales) Order 1994 and shall come into force on 21st November 1994.

**2.** There are hereby conferred on those police authorities established under section 3 of the Police Act 1964<sup>(2)</sup> which are, by virtue of section 3 (2) of that Act, known by the names listed in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, the alternative names in Welsh specified opposite thereto in column 2 of that Schedule.
