**The Al-Qa'ida and Taliban (United Nations Measures)
(Amendment) Order 2002**

Made - - - - - 12th February 2002

Laid before Parliament 13th February 2002

Coming into force - - 14th February 2002

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 12th day of February 2002

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the United Nations Act 1946(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Al-Qa'ida and Taliban (United Nations Measures) (Amendment) Order 2002 and shall come into force on 14th February 2002.

(2) This Order and the Al-Qa'ida and Taliban (United Nations Measures) Order 2002(b) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”) may be cited together as the Al-Qa'ida and Taliban (United Nations Measures) Orders 2002.

2. In Article 1(4) of the principal Order, the words, “Articles 6, 7 and 8” shall be replaced by the words “Articles 6, 7, 8 and 9”.
