The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the power conferred by section 11 of the Football Spectators Act 1989⁽¹⁾. In accordance with section 11(4) of that Act he has consulted with the Football Licensing Authority.

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Football Spectators (Seating) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 3rd July 2009.

Direction

2.—(1) The Secretary of State directs the Football Licensing Authority as set out in paragraph (2).

(2) When granting any licence to admit spectators⁽²⁾ to the premises specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 and further identified in column (2) of that Schedule by the name of the football club of which they are the home ground, the Football Licensing Authority shall include in that licence a condition imposing the requirements, as respects the seating of spectators at designated football matches⁽³⁾, specified in Schedule 2.

This Order directs the Football Licensing Authority to include in any licence to admit spectators to the Cardiff City Stadium a condition imposing the requirements that only seated accommodation is to be provided for spectators at a designated football match and that spectators shall only be admitted to
