The M61 Motorway (Junction 2 Northbound Link Road to the A666 from the A580) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M61 Motorway and its link roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the City of Salford in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as The M61 Motorway (Junction 2 Northbound Link Road to the A666 from the A580) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 24 January 2010.
- 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M61 Motorway;

"the link road" means the northbound link road of the motorway at Junction 2 leading to the A666 St Peters Way from the A580 East Lancashire Road, westbound carriageway.

"works" means gantry works on the link road;

"the works period" means periods over two nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 25 January 2010 and ending on Friday 29 January 2010. However, works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights, or continue until completed.

3.	Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle
	to enter or proceed in the link road during the works period.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services or by traffic officers, or to anything done with the permission of, or at the direction of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
